

Grain Bank Policy

Grain Bank is defined as grain delivered to Frontier Cooperative for the purpose of being processed into livestock feed. No other commodities can be placed in Grain Bank.

Grain Bank Storage will be figured from the actual date of delivery at a rate of \$.00165/bushel/day.

All grain received for Grain Bank will be subject to Frontier's normal grain discount schedule.

All corn will be shrunk, and discounted for moisture to 15.0% moisture.

Whole corn hauled out of Grain Bank will be charged handling fees of \$.18/bushel in, and \$.18/bushel out.
